CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Tournament is sanctioned by and will be held under the Rules, Regulations and Code of Conduct of Tennis Ireland. Entrants shall adhere to the rules of Windsor LTC.
2. Entries will be accepted only if made on Official Entry Forms, accompanied by the appropriate entry fees (**cheques made payable to Windsor Lawn Tennis Club**) and sent to the Tournament Secretary, Windsor LTC, 37 Windsor Avenue, Belfast BT9 6EJ (Tel: 028 9066 5188).
3. Players may enter a maximum of **two** Singles events and **one** Doubles event.
4. Novice events are limited to players who have never reached the second round or further in the main events (not plates) of a Tennis Ireland tournament. Club tournaments or matchplays do not count. Players entering novice events may also enter main events up to the maximum permitted entry as in rule 3.
5. In accordance with Tennis Ireland Regulations, entrants must give precedence to tournament matches over **any other** competitions.
6. In accordance with Tennis Ireland guidelines, players eligible for Under 10 events will not be permitted to enter the Under 12 open events unless they hold a valid Tennis Ireland passport. A copy of the passport should accompany any entry. Players eligible for Under 10 events will be permitted to enter the Under 12 Novice events; these events will be played using the ITF Stage 1 (Green) ball.
7. Entries close for **ALL** events on **Thursday 18th August 2011 at 6:00 P.M.** The draw will be made on **Friday 19th August.**
8. In all matters, the Referee's decision will be **final**.
9. Persons entering must be under the stipulated age of each event on 31st December 2010.
10. Predominantly white, recognised tennis attire and appropriate shoes must be worn. Tee-shirts are not permitted. This rule will be strictly enforced and the decision of the Referee or his deputies on matters of dress shall be final.
11. Play will commence at 8:30 a.m. each day unless deemed otherwise by the Referee. Players must be available at these times if required and any player not present to play will be scratched.
12. Championship matches will be the best of 3 tie-break sets. A championship tie-break (first to 10 points) may be played as an alternative to a third set in some events.
13. Five Grasshopper courts will be used at the discretion of the Referee. Players may also be required to play at another venue and/or another surface.
14. Dunlop Fort balls will be the official tournament ball though another ball may be used as required.
15. **It is the responsibility of competitors to find out when they are due to play each day from www.ulster-junior-hardcourt.org.uk as soon as it is available.**
16. Competitors must report to the referee's desk upon arrival each day. Failure to do so may result in a competitor being scratched as absent when called upon to play. Players should not leave the club grounds without informing the Referee.
17. Fees must be paid in full before competitors play their first match. Entries received without a fee will be subject to an additional charge of £2.00.
18. All players must be available to play on the first and second days if required.
19. **By entering the tournament you give permission for your child to be photographed and/or filmed by or on behalf of the committee for promotional purposes. If you do not permit this please inform the Tournament Referee.**
20. Any complaints regarding the Tournament must be made in accordance with the rules and regulations of Tennis Ireland, and be made in writing within 48 hours of same.
21. Players may be asked to undergo a drugs test in accordance within the present rules of Tennis Ireland.
22. Events may be withdrawn if there are insufficient entries.
